
Wine List – April 2011 – March 2012

Champagne & Sparkling Wines

Prosecco Spagorosso, Domenico de Bertiol, Italy

This great mixing sparkling wine from Italy has beautifully soft peachy fruits which combine well with the delicate mousse to make this perfect aperitif and amazing Bellini.

Los Gansos Sparkling Brut, Chile – Ethical Wine

This sparkling wine is produced by the Cono Sur winery in Central Valley. Los Gansos means geese in Spanish and the winery use this name because they have flocks of wild geese living in the vineyards who eat the pests that attack the vines. Far too good to mix for cocktails, this outstanding sparkling wine is made from a blend of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir grapes which give it a delicate floral and citrus aromas and a fresh lingering finish.

Prosecco di Valdobbiadene, Italy

Very fashionable and a perfect alternative to Champagne. Flavour is balanced with delicate fruity notes, low acidity and moderate alcohol content.

Meopham Valley, Sparkling Rosé, England – Sustainable Wine

At last, a delicious English sparkling wine with a light, aromatic and refreshing acidity that balances nicely on the palate. Definitely a risk worth taking!

Champagne Autréau NV, France

A small family-owned Champagne house has produced this Champagne since 1670 in the village of Champillon. A blend of Pinot Noir & Pinto Meunier. It has a rich fruit and mouth filling style, a lively mousse fresh balanced taste and delicacy, consistently displaying the house style.

Gremillet Champagne, Cuvée des Dames Blanc de Blanc, France

This classy Champagne is Gremillet's top Cuvée and shows clean, ripe flavours with a classic yeasty nose and complex toasted Chardonnay finish. In our opinion this Champagne is arguably in the same league as Moët and Heidsieck and we think it probably leaves Lanson in reserve!

Champagne Joseph Perrier Cuvée Royale NV, France

This Champagne is blended by the traditional mixture of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier to create a beautiful pale yellow hue. It has a good mousse and full biscuity flavour.



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White Wine

Ca'di Ponti, Caterratto, Italy

This pale lemon coloured wine from Sicily is crisp and zesty with gentle, ripe fruit flavours and a refreshing hint of citrus.

Los Gansos, Sauvignon Blanc, Chile – Ethical Wine

Produced in the Cono Sur winery in Central Valley, Los Gansos means geese in Spanish and the winery use this name because they have flocks of wild geese living in the vineyards who eat the pests that attack the vines. This attractive Sauvignon Blanc is a pale yellow colour with a slight green tinge. The citrus and green apple aromas offer a citrus fresh taste with a well-balanced mineral finish.

Meopham Valley, Pinot Gris, England – Sustainable Wine

From Meopham Valley in Kent – just 24 miles from our door, David Grey and friends planted the vines in 1990 and has been making great wine since 2006. This exciting new vintage offering a light fresh palate while offering delicate scents of the Garden of England including elderflower and cut grass.

Los Almendros, Sauvignon Blanc, Chile – Fair-trade Wine

Described as much more than just a great glass of wine and with a fair price being paid to farmers this fresh fruity Sauvignon Blanc from the Curico Valley has bright elderflower fruit characters and a lovely crisp finish.

Viñedos de la Posada, Torrentes, Argentina – Fair-trade Wine

From La Rioja in Argentinas Famatina Valley, this delicious white Torrontes wine has soft floral aromas and a lively, ripe, green fruit palate.

Bodegas Sierra, Norte Macabeo & Sauvignon Blanc, Spain – Organic Wine

The combination of hot, dry summers, cold nights and poor limestone soil make the area relatively free of vine diseases and so ideal for organic farming. The entire estate is now dedicated to organic production and produces a crisp white wine that is lightly aromatic, with peach and passion fruit characters on the nose.



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White Wine

Sierra Grande, Sauvignon Blanc, Chile

A great Sauvignon Blanc...Ripe gooseberry, lime and elderflower aromas; a charming wine with a bold fruity finish.

Conviviale, Pinot Grigio, Italy

This is a perfect Pinot Grigio – a pretty, pale lemon colour, lively fresh fruit on the palate with juicy citrus characters to follow.

Maçon Lugny, Louis Latour, France

A clean, crisp and extremely versatile wine, which is the benchmark for Burgundy, coming from one of the top vineyards in the Maconnais region. This wine is opulent and rich with a flowery bouquet and a full, buttery palate.

Chablis, La Pierrelée La Chablisienne, France

An aromatic, full-bodied Premier Cru from one of the top producers of Chablis. It is dry with steely fruit and citrus overtones. Ideal with white meats, fish, light cheeses, or salads.

Sancerre Domaine Balland, France

A Classic Loire favourite, this wine has a lovely ripe fruity flavour, plenty of freshness and snap, and a touch of mineral at the back end. A wine that will keep you coming back for more!

Pouilly Fume Dom du Bouchot, France

Almost Straw coloured with a strong but subtle nose, Full Flavour on the palate with a long finish.

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Red Wine

Ca di' Ponte, Nero d'Avola, Italy

This is a warm, rich red wine from Sicily with its characteristic black fruit and spicy clean tannins.

Los Gansos, Merlot, Chile – Ethical Wine

Produced by the Cono Sur winery in Central Valley, Los Gansos means geese in Spanish and the winery use this name because they have flocks of wild geese living in the vineyards who eat the pests that attack the vines. This Merlot has an intense plum colour with fruity blackberry aromas. It has enough sweetness to drink alone in addition to a well-structured body which makes it a perfect partner to food.

Los Almendros, Cabernet Sauvignon & Carmènere, Chile – Fair-trade Wine

*Described as much more than just a great glass of wine and with a fair price being paid to farmers this beautiful wine offers ripe blackcurrant fruit of the Cabernet grape to compliment the plummy softer fruit of the Carmènere grape to excite us with this great wine.

Viñedos de la Posada, Merlot, Argentina – Fair-trade Wine

*From La Rioja in Argentina's Famatina Valley, this openly accessible red wine offers soft rich black fruit flavours.

Bodegas Sierra Norte, Bobal & Cabernet Sauvignon, Spain – Organic Wine

The combination of hot, dry summers, cold nights and poor limestone soil make the area relatively free of vine diseases and so ideal for organic farming. The entire estate is now dedicated to organic production. The juicy bramble fruit and fresh blackberries with soft tannins make this medal winning organic wine an easy drinking house choice.

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Red Wine

Sierra Grande Merlot, Chile

An intensely fruity Chilean Merlot full of positive bold dark fruit flavours; excellent with rich, spicy food.

Rioja, Vega Piedra, Spain

A modern, unoaked Tempranillo full of red fruits, fresh cherries and plums with hints of spice. A lovely soft and easy to drink Rioja.

Brouilly Ch. de la Pierre, Beaujolais, France

Beaujolais at its best. A light medium bodied wine, packed full of fruit and very refreshing, ideal at lunchtime and with cold meats and charcuterie.

Mr Smith, McLaren Vale, Shiraz, Australia

We are very excited to introduce this rich multi-layered Shiraz from McLaren Vale, Australia. The ripe blackberry and chocolate characters offer weight, charm and balance to this rather delicious wine.

Hautes Côtes de Beaune, Domaine des Trois Monts, France

Medium bodied with ripe berry fruit flavours. The natural acidity of this wine makes it an ideal companion for lamb and beef.

Gigondas Vieilles Vignes, Domaine du Grand Montmirail, France

A strong and complex blend of spicy red fruits with aromas of liquorice and soft tannins. This is a chunky wine that neighbours Chateau Neuf-du-Pape but offers superb value.

Château Lamothe Bergeron, Cru Bourgeois Haut Médoc, France

An excellent example of a Cru Bourgeois at its best. Made predominantly from Cabernet Sauvignon this wine exhibits ripe plummy fruit flavours and fine grained tannins. This is a wine of great complexity and finesse.



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Rosé Wine

Mirabello Pinot Grigio Rosé, Italy

A charming Pinot Grigio rosé with an attractive pale pink colour and full of lovely berry fruit flavours.

Bellefontaine Rosé de Syrah, France

This fine and elegant French rosé with a pinkish orange hue is packed with sweet summer fruit flavours with a soft spice note from the Syrah.

Meopham Valley, England – Sustainable Wine

A fantastic perfumed off-dry rosé made from Reichensteiner and Triomphe grapes from the 2009 vintage. The wine has been bottled under screw cap to preserve the fruit aroma and to ensure that the wine is always in top condition when you open it.

Dessert Wine

Campbell`s Liqueur Muscat NV, Australia (375cl)

This wine has smooth and sweet grapey flavours backed by well-balanced acidity, which leads to a clean and refreshing finish. Try drizzling over vanilla ice cream for a mouth-watering dessert!

Royal Tokaji Ats Cuvee Late Harvest, Hungary (50cl)

A wine made up of the 3 main grape varieties in the region. The ratios can vary depending on the vintage itself, naturally preserving the unique fruity aromas.

Chateau Laurette, St Croix di Mont, France (375ml)

An extremely beautiful dessert wine from this tiny appellation that sits just east of the majestic Sauternes district. With appealing floral and honeyed aromas and luscious apricot fruit characters on the palate, this is a very well balanced wine.

Essensia Orange Muscat, California (375ml)

A charming bold, dessert wine from Andrew Quady. Full of vivid orange, pineapple and tropical fruit characters.

Royal Tokaji Aszu 5 Puttonyos, Hungary (50cl)

This is the wine that is in most distribution internationally. Consistent and well balanced, a pioneer for the renaissance of Tokaji wines.
